Grassland Ecosystem Ecology Biology JC/LC

Students will conduct an investigation of a grassland ecosystem. The study will include a qualitative and quantitative plant survey, and animal collection and identification.

Need to know...

How long can we spend in Emerald Park?

Included in your package during PEAK SEASON is a full day entrance to Emerald Park with unlimited use of the attractions. You must meet your tour guide at the designated meeting point 15 minutes before your tour begins.

Please note: If your time at Emerald Park is limited then you may not get to experience all available activities.

What happens if it rains on the day?

Emerald Park is an outdoor park. Everything will operate as normal for your tour should it rain (with the exception of inclement weather), however, we do advise to bring rain gear and a change of clothes.

Do we have to pay a deposit?

A 25% deposit must be paid within 14 days of booking and full payment must be made before groups are permitted to enter the park. All deposits are non-refundable. All school tours must be pre-booked.

Note: All rides are subject to minimum/maximum height, weight, lap bar and weather restrictions. Packages excludes the Sky Walk attraction.
